

SENATE BILL No. 800

October 24, 2001, Introduced by Senators BENNETT, JOHNSON, SMITH, GAST, DUNASKISS, BULLARD, MC MANUS, HART, NORTH, DE BEAUSSAERT, KOIVISTO, DINGELL, HOFFMAN, SIKKEMA, STEIL, SHUGARS, SCHUETTE, GOUGEON, HAMMERSTROM, GOSCHKA, GARCIA and SCHWARZ and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 43704 (MCL 324.43704), as amended by 2001 PA 50.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 43704. (1) The state treasurer shall direct the
2 investment of the trust fund. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL HAVE THE
3 SAME AUTHORITY TO INVEST THE ASSETS OF THE TRUST FUND AS IS
4 GRANTED TO AN INVESTMENT FIDUCIARY UNDER THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEE
5 RETIREMENT SYSTEM INVESTMENT ACT, 1965 PA 314, MCL 38.1132 TO

7 (2) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL ANNUALLY PREPARE AN ACCOUNTING
8 OF REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES FROM THE TRUST FUND. THIS
9 ACCOUNTING SHALL SPECIFICALLY IDENTIFY THE INTEREST AND EARNINGS
10 OF THE TRUST FUND, SHALL DESCRIBE HOW THE AMOUNT OF INTEREST AND

1 EARNINGS HAS BEEN AFFECTED BY THE EXPANDED INVESTMENT OPTIONS
2 PROVIDED FOR IN SUBSECTION (1), AND SHALL IDENTIFY HOW THE
3 INCREASED INTEREST AND EARNINGS, IF ANY, HAVE BEEN EXPENDED.
