## **SENATE BILL No. 912**

December 4, 2001, Introduced by Senator MC COTTER and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1905 PA 311, entitled

"An act with respect to the furnishing of bonds by state officers, their deputies, and officers of state institutions; to provide for the payment of the cost of such bonds, and to prescribe the places of filing the same,"

by amending sections 1 and 2 (MCL 15.71 to 15.72).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. Whenever a bond is required by the laws of this
- 2 state to be given by the <del>auditor general,</del> secretary of state,
- 3 state treasurer, commissioner of the state land office DIRECTOR
- 4 OF THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, attorney general, or
- 5 superintendent of public instruction, or the deputy or deputies
- 6 of said THOSE officers, or any other civil or military offi-
- 7 cer of the THIS state, or any officer of any state institution,
- 8 whether elected or appointed, who is charged with the duty of
- 9 being the custodian of any state or institution funds, money, or
