- 3 (a) Are responsible for all phases of the operation of the
- 4 hospital, selection of the medical staff, and quality of care
- 5 rendered in the hospital.
- (b) Shall cooperate with the department in the enforcement
- 7 of this part, and require that the physicians, dentists, and
- 8 other personnel working in the hospital and for whom a license
- **9 or registration is required be WHO ARE REQUIRED TO BE LICENSED**
- 10 OR REGISTERED ARE IN FACT currently licensed or registered.
