A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 16611 (MCL 333.16611).

#### THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 16611. (1) A person AN INDIVIDUAL shall not engage
- 2 in the practice of dentistry, the practice as a dental hygienist,
- 3 or the practice as a dental assistant unless HE OR SHE IS
- 4 licensed or otherwise authorized by this article.
- 5 (2) Deep scaling, root planing, and the removal of calcar-
- 6 eous deposits may only be performed by individuals AN
- 7 INDIVIDUAL licensed OR OTHERWISE AUTHORIZED BY THIS ARTICLE as a
- 8 dental hygienist or a dentist.
- 9 (3) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT ISSUE A DENTAL HYGIENIST'S
- 10 LICENSE TO AN INDIVIDUAL UNLESS THE INDIVIDUAL HAS GRADUATED FROM
- 11 A SCHOOL OR COLLEGE FOR DENTAL HYGIENISTS WHOSE DENTAL HYGIENE
