SUBSTITUTE FOR

SENATE BILL NO. 1383

(As passed the Senate, November 13, 2002)

A bill to amend 1990 PA 182, entitled

"An act to require counties to redistribute certain payments received from the federal government; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

by amending sections 1 and 3 (MCL 141.1301 and 141.1303).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (A) "COUNTY PAYMENT PROGRAM" MEANS THE PROGRAM AUTHORIZED
- 3 UNDER CHAPTER 192, 35 STAT. 260, 16 U.S.C. 500, INCLUDING THE
- 4 SECURE RURAL SCHOOLS AND COMMUNITY SELF-DETERMINATION ACT OF
- **5** 2000.
- **6** (B) "DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES.
- 7 (C) "DIRECTOR" MEANS THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT.
- 8 (D) "FULL PAYMENT AMOUNT" AND "25-PERCENT PAYMENT" MEAN
- 9 THOSE TERMS AS DEFINED IN THE SECURE RURAL SCHOOLS AND COMMUNITY
- 10 SELF-DETERMINATION ACT OF 2000.

- 2 in section 6 of the REVISED school code, of 1976, Act No. 451 of

- 5 (F) (B) "National forest" means federally owned land for
- 6 which money is paid to the state under 35 Stat. 260, 16
- 7 U.S.C. 500 THE COUNTY PAYMENT PROGRAM, as that land is situated
- 8 on June 30 of the fiscal year for which the money is paid.
- 9 (G) "SECURE RURAL SCHOOLS AND COMMUNITY SELF-DETERMINATION
- 10 ACT OF 2000" MEANS PUBLIC LAW 106-393, 114 STAT. 1607, 16
- **11** U.S.C. 500 NT.
- 12 Sec. 3. (1) All money received under 35 Stat. 260, 16
- 13 U.S.C. 500, THE COUNTY PAYMENT PROGRAM shall be expended for
- 14 school purposes and county roads in the counties in which
- 15 national forests are situated THE PURPOSES DESCRIBED UNDER CHAP-
- 16 TER 192, 35 STAT. 260, 16 U.S.C. 500, INCLUDING THE SECURE RURAL
- 17 SCHOOLS AND COMMUNITY SELF-DETERMINATION ACT OF 2000. The money
- 18 shall be distributed to those counties in the same proportion as
- 19 the national forest acreage in each county is to the total
- 20 national forest acreage in the state EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUB-
- 21 SECTION (11), THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DISTRIBUTE MONEY TO THE COUN-
- 22 TIES IN ACCORDANCE WITH ANNUAL AMOUNTS PROVIDED BY THE UNITED
- 23 STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, FOREST SERVICE.
- 24 (2) UPON REQUEST OF THE DEPARTMENT AND AS REQUIRED UNDER THE
- 25 SECURE RURAL SCHOOLS AND COMMUNITY SELF-DETERMINATION ACT OF
- 26 2000, THE TREASURER OF A COUNTY THAT IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A
- 27 PAYMENT UNDER THE COUNTY PAYMENT PROGRAM SHALL PROVIDE WRITTEN

- 1 NOTIFICATION TO THE DIRECTOR THAT INDICATES THE COUNTY BOARD OF
- 2 COMMISSIONERS' ELECTION TO RECEIVE EITHER THE FULL PAYMENT AMOUNT
- 3 OR THE 25-PERCENT PAYMENT AMOUNT. HOWEVER, NO WRITTEN NOTIFICA-
- 4 TION IS REQUIRED FOR THE 2 YEARS SUCCEEDING THE ELECTION MADE IN
- 5 THIS SUBSECTION OR FISCAL YEAR 2006, WHICHEVER COMES FIRST. THE
- 6 ELECTION BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS IS SUBJECT TO ALL
- 7 OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 8 (A) AN ELECTION MADE BY A COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO
- 9 RECEIVE THE FULL PAYMENT AMOUNT SHALL REMAIN IN EFFECT THROUGH
- **10** FISCAL YEAR 2006.
- 11 (B) AN ELECTION BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO
- 12 RECEIVE THE 25-PERCENT PAYMENT AMOUNT SHALL REMAIN IN EFFECT FOR
- 13 2 FISCAL YEARS.
- 14 (C) IF A COUNTY FAILS TO PROVIDE NOTIFICATION TO THE DIREC-
- 15 TOR BY A DATE ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT, THE COUNTY IS CON-
- 16 SIDERED TO HAVE ELECTED TO RECEIVE THE 25-PERCENT PAYMENT
- **17** AMOUNT.
- 18 (D) IF THE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ELECTS TO RECEIVE
- 19 THE FULL PAYMENT AMOUNT, THE WRITTEN NOTIFICATION SHALL ALSO
- 20 INCLUDE THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF THE PAYMENT THAT WILL BE SET ASIDE
- 21 FOR EACH OF THE USES PROVIDED FOR IN SUBSECTION (5)(B) AND THE
- 22 COUNTY TREASURER SHALL PROVIDE A COPY OF THE NOTIFICATION TO THE
- 23 UNITED STATES SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURE. IF THE COUNTY TREASURER
- 24 FAILS TO PROVIDE NOTIFICATION TO THE DIRECTOR AND THE UNITED
- 25 STATES SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURE PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION AND
- 26 PAYMENT TO THE COUNTY IS EQUAL TO OR GREATER THAN \$100,000.00,
- 27 THE COUNTY TREASURER SHALL RETURN 15% OF THE PAYMENT TO THE

- 1 GENERAL TREASURY OF THE UNITED STATES AND SHALL USE THE REMAINING
- 2 FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSES SET FORTH IN SUBSECTION (4).
- 3 (3) AS REQUIRED UNDER THE SECURE RURAL SCHOOLS AND COMMUNITY
- 4 SELF-DETERMINATION ACT OF 2000, THE GOVERNOR SHALL PROVIDE WRIT-
- 5 TEN NOTIFICATION TO THE UNITED STATES SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURE OF
- 6 THE ELECTION MADE FOR EACH ELIGIBLE COUNTY.
- 7 (4) (2) The IF A COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ELECTS TO
- 8 RECEIVE THE 25-PERCENT PAYMENT AMOUNT, THE COUNTY treasurer of a
- 9 county receiving money under this section shall redistribute all
- 10 of the money in a ratio of 75% to local school districts for
- 11 school purposes and 25% to townships for the improvement of
- 12 county roads within those townships. The money redistributed
- 13 under this -section SUBSECTION shall be apportioned among the
- 14 local school districts and townships in the same proportion as
- 15 the national forest acreage in each school district or township
- 16 is to the total national forest acreage in the county.
- 17 (5) IF A COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ELECTS TO RECEIVE THE
- 18 FULL PAYMENT AMOUNT, FOR ANY FISCAL YEAR THE PAYMENT TO THE
- 19 COUNTY EQUALS OR EXCEEDS \$100,000.00, THE TREASURER SHALL DO BOTH
- 20 OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 21 (A) REDISTRIBUTE NOT LESS THAN 80% AND NOT MORE THAN 85% OF
- 22 THE FUNDS AS PROVIDED FOR IN SUBSECTION (4).
- 23 (B) SET ASIDE THE REMAINING FUNDS FOR 1 OR MORE OF THE
- 24 FOLLOWING:
- 25 (i) RESERVE THE BALANCE FOR SPECIAL PROJECTS ON FEDERAL
- 26 LANDS AS PROVIDED FOR IN TITLE II OF THE SECURE RURAL SCHOOLS AND
- 27 COMMUNITY SELF-DETERMINATION ACT OF 2000.

- 1 (ii) RESERVE THE BALANCE FOR COUNTY PROJECTS AS PROVIDED FOR
- 2 IN TITLE III OF THE SECURE RURAL SCHOOLS AND COMMUNITY
- 3 SELF-DETERMINATION ACT OF 2000.
- 4 (iii) RETURN THE BALANCE TO THE GENERAL TREASURY OF THE
- 5 UNITED STATES.
- 6 (6) IF A COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ELECTS TO RECEIVE THE
- 7 FULL PAYMENT AMOUNT, FOR ANY FISCAL YEAR THE PAYMENT TO THE
- 8 COUNTY IS LESS THAN \$100,000.00, THE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSION-
- 9 ERS MAY ELECT TO SET ASIDE BETWEEN 15% AND 20% OF THE PAYMENT FOR
- 10 THE PURPOSES SET FORTH IN SUBSECTION (5)(B) AND REDISTRIBUTE THE
- 11 REMAINING FUNDS AS PROVIDED FOR IN SUBSECTION (4).
- 12 (7) UPON EXPIRATION OF THE ELECTION PROVISIONS OF THE SECURE
- 13 RURAL SCHOOLS AND COMMUNITY SELF-DETERMINATION ACT OF 2000, A
- 14 COUNTY TREASURER THAT RECEIVES PAYMENT UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL
- 15 REDISTRIBUTE ALL OF THE MONEY AS PROVIDED FOR IN SUBSECTION (4).
- 16 (8) THE DIRECTOR SHALL ESTABLISH ANNUAL REPORTING REQUIRE-
- 17 MENTS AND DEADLINES FOR THE COUNTIES THAT RECEIVE PAYMENTS UNDER
- 18 THIS SECTION. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS MAY INCLUDE THE PREPARATION
- 19 OF FINANCIAL RECORDS, NARRATIVE REPORTS, AND OTHER WRITTEN DOCU-
- 20 MENTATION SUBMITTED BY THE COUNTY TREASURER THAT DEMONSTRATE ALL
- 21 OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 22 (A) THAT THE COUNTY TREASURER HAS PROPERLY DISTRIBUTED FUNDS
- 23 TO LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND TOWNSHIPS AS PROVIDED FOR IN SUB-
- **24** SECTION (4).
- 25 (B) THAT FUNDS DISTRIBUTED TO THE LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND
- 26 TOWNSHIPS WERE USED FOR SCHOOLS AND ROADS AS PROVIDED FOR IN THE

- 1 SECURE RURAL SCHOOLS AND COMMUNITY SELF-DETERMINATION ACT OF
- **2** 2000.
- 3 (C) THAT FUNDS SET ASIDE FOR COUNTY PROJECTS AS PROVIDED FOR
- 4 IN SUBSECTION (5)(B)(ii) WERE EXPENDED IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE
- 5 SECURE RURAL SCHOOLS AND COMMUNITY SELF-DETERMINATION ACT OF 2000
- 6 AND THIS ACT. THE REPORTING REQUIREMENTS MAY INCLUDE DETAILED
- 7 NARRATIVE REPORTS AND DOCUMENTATION OF COUNTY EXPENDITURES.
- 8 (D) THAT PAYMENTS WERE MADE TO THE GENERAL TREASURY OF THE
- 9 UNITED STATES AS SET FORTH IN SUBSECTIONS (2)(D) AND
- **10** (5)(B)(*iii*).
- 11 (9) A COUNTY TREASURER WHO ACCEPTS PAYMENT UNDER THE COUNTY
- 12 PAYMENT PROGRAM AGREES TO COMPLY WITH THE REPORTING REQUIREMENTS
- 13 AND DEADLINES ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT. A COUNTY TREASURER
- 14 MAY ESTABLISH REPORTING REQUIREMENTS FOR COUNTY AGENCIES, LOCAL
- 15 SCHOOL DISTRICTS, OR TOWNSHIPS IN ORDER TO COMPLY WITH THE
- 16 REPORTING REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- 17 (10) THE DIRECTOR MAY WITHHOLD FUTURE YEAR PAYMENTS TO A
- 18 COUNTY THAT FAILS TO COMPLY WITH THE REPORTING REQUIREMENTS UNDER
- 19 THIS SECTION OR THAT DOES NOT ADEQUATELY DOCUMENT THAT THE FUNDS
- 20 WERE DISTRIBUTED AND EXPENDED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SECURE RURAL
- 21 SCHOOLS AND COMMUNITY SELF-DETERMINATION ACT OF 2000 AND THIS
- 22 ACT. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE THE COUNTY TREASURER WRITTEN
- 23 NOTIFICATION THAT PAYMENT IS BEING WITHHELD AND THE DEFICIENCIES
- 24 IN THE REPORTS OR DOCUMENTATION. IF THE COUNTY TREASURER FAILS
- 25 TO CORRECT THE DEFICIENCIES TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE DEPARTMENT
- 26 WITHIN 90 DAYS, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE A WRITTEN
- 27 EXPLANATION TO THE UNITED STATES SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURE AND

- 1 SHALL RETURN THE FUNDS TO THE GENERAL TREASURY OF THE UNITED
- 2 STATES.
- 3 (11) THE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF A COUNTY THAT IS
- ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A PAYMENT OF EQUAL TO OR LESS THAN \$100.00
- UNDER THE COUNTY PAYMENT PROGRAM MAY OPT TO NOT RECEIVE AND 5
- 6 REDISTRIBUTE THE MONEY BY PROVIDING WRITTEN NOTICE UPON REQUEST
- 7 OF THE DEPARTMENT. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DISTRIBUTE MONEY
- REJECTED BY A COUNTY UNDER THIS SUBSECTION TO THE COUNTY THAT HAS 8
- 9 LAND WITHIN THE SAME NATIONAL FOREST AND THAT WOULD OTHERWISE
- 10 RECEIVE THE SMALLEST PAYMENT IN THE SAME FISCAL YEAR. IF THERE
- IS NOT ANOTHER COUNTY THAT HAS LAND WITHIN THE SAME NATIONAL 11
- 12 FOREST THAT WILL RECEIVE PAYMENT, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DISTRIBUTE
- 13 THE MONEY TO THE COUNTY THAT WOULD OTHERWISE RECEIVE THE SMALLEST
- 14 PAYMENT IN THE SAME FISCAL YEAR.
