by amending section 48 of chapter XVII (MCL 777.48), as amended by 2000 PA 279.

- 7 (a) The offender operated a vehicle, vessel, ORV,
- 8 snowmobile, aircraft, or locomotive when his or her

- 12 resulting from the consumption of intoxicating liquor other than
- 13 the consumption of intoxicating liquor as part of a generally
- 14 recognized religious service or ceremony.
