## **HOUSE BILL No. 4248**

February 14, 2001, Introduced by Reps. Kowall, Gilbert, Bishop, Allen, Kooiman, Van Woerkom, Shackleton, Hager, George, Richardville, Vear, Stewart, Julian, Vander Veen, Patterson, Faunce, Bovin, Rocca, Koetje, DeVuyst, Richner, Mortimer and Raczkowski and referred to the Committee on Conservation and Outdoor Recreation.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 3101 (MCL 324.3101), as amended by 1997 PA 29, and by adding section 3109c.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3101. As used in this part:
- 2 (A) "AOUATIC NUISANCE SPECIES" MEANS A NONINDIGENOUS SPECIES
- 3 THAT THREATENS THE DIVERSITY OR ABUNDANCE OF NATIVE SPECIES OR
- 4 THE ECOLOGICAL STABILITY OF INFESTED WATERS, OR COMMERCIAL, AGRI-
- 5 CULTURAL, AQUACULTURAL, OR RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES DEPENDENT ON
- 6 SUCH WATERS.
- 7 (B) "BALLAST WATER" MEANS WATER AND ASSOCIATED SOLIDS TAKEN
- 8 ON BOARD A VESSEL TO CONTROL OR MAINTAIN TRIM, DRAFT, STABILITY,
- 9 OR STRESSES ON THE VESSEL, WITHOUT REGARD TO THE MANNER IN WHICH
- 10 IT IS CARRIED.

- 3 (D) (b) "Detroit consumer price index" means the most com-

- 19 industrial waste.

- 22 solid waste or other waste regulated under this act.

- 24 erates sewage sludge that is applied to land.
- 25 (1)  $\overline{\text{(h)}}$  "Sewage sludge distributor" means a person who
- 26 applies, markets, or distributes, except at retail, a sewage
- 27 sludge derivative.

- 1 (M) "ST. LAWRENCE WATERWAY" MEANS THE ST. LAWRENCE RIVER,
- 2 THE ST. LAWRENCE SEAWAY, AND THE GULF OF ST. LAWRENCE.
- 3 (N) "STERILIZED" MEANS THE TREATMENT OF BALLAST WATER OR
- 4 SEDIMENTS, OR BOTH, TO REMOVE OR DESTROY LIVING BIOLOGICAL ORGAN-
- 5 ISMS THROUGH 1 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 6 (i) FILTRATION.
- 7 (ii) THE APPLICATION OF BIOCIDES OR ULTRAVIOLET LIGHT.
- 8 (iii) THERMAL METHODS.
- 9 (iv) OTHER TREATMENT TECHNIQUES APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- 10 (0)  $\frac{(i)}{(i)}$  "Waters of the state" means groundwaters, lakes,
- 11 rivers, and streams and all other watercourses and waters,
- 12 INCLUDING THE GREAT LAKES, within the jurisdiction of this
- 13 state. and also the Great Lakes bordering this state.
- 14 SEC. 3109C. (1) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2006, A PERSON SHALL
- 15 NOT OPERATE A COMMERCIAL VESSEL CAPABLE OF DISCHARGING BALLAST
- 16 WATER, WHETHER EQUIPPED WITH A BALLAST WATER TANK SYSTEM OR OTH-
- 17 ERWISE, ON THE GREAT LAKES WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE
- 18 UNLESS THAT VESSEL IS EQUIPPED WITH AN ON-BOARD BALLAST WATER
- 19 MONITORING SYSTEM. THE ON-BOARD BALLAST WATER MONITORING SYSTEM
- 20 REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL DO BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 21 (A) PROVIDE FOR ONGOING MONITORING OF BALLAST WATER AND SED-
- 22 IMENTS FOR THE PRESENCE OF AQUATIC NUISANCE SPECIES.
- 23 (B) PROVIDE FOR THE RESULTS OF THE MONITORING SYSTEM UNDER
- 24 SUBDIVISION (A) TO BE AVAILABLE TO THE DEPARTMENT ELECTRONICALLY
- 25 VIA SATELLITE TRANSMISSION.
- 26 (2) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2006, A PERSON SHALL NOT DISCHARGE
- 27 BALLAST WATER OR SEDIMENTS FROM A COMMERCIAL VESSEL INTO THE

- 1 WATERS OF THE STATE UNLESS THAT PERSON IS IN COMPLIANCE WITH
- 2 SUBSECTION (1) AND HAS BEEN ISSUED A DISCHARGE PERMIT FROM THE
- 3 DEPARTMENT. A PERMIT ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL NOT ALLOW
- 4 THE DISCHARGE OF BALLAST WATER OR SEDIMENTS INTO THE WATERS OF
- 5 THE STATE UNLESS THE BALLAST WATER AND SEDIMENTS HAVE BEEN STER-
- 6 ILIZED TO PREVENT THE INTRODUCTION AND SPREAD OF AQUATIC NUISANCE
- 7 SPECIES IN THE GREAT LAKES.
- 8 (3) AN APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT UNDER SUBSECTION (2) SHALL
- 9 BE SUBMITTED IN THE MANNER REQUIRED BY THE DEPARTMENT AND SHALL
- 10 CONTAIN THE INFORMATION REQUIRED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- 11 (4) BY JUNE 30, 2002, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROMULGATE RULES
- 12 TO IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION. IN PROMULGATING RULES UNDER THIS SEC-
- 13 TION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CONSULT WITH OTHER STATES AND CANADIAN
- 14 PROVINCES BORDERING THE GREAT LAKES AND THE ST. LAWRENCE
- **15** WATERWAY.
- 16 (5) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL SUSPEND ENFORCEMENT OF THE REQUIRE-
- 17 MENTS OF THIS SECTION AND THE RULES PROMULGATED UNDER THIS SEC-
- 18 TION IF A FEDERAL LAW IS ENACTED OR FEDERAL REGULATIONS ARE
- 19 PROMULGATED AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION THAT REQUIRE
- 20 COMMERCIAL VESSELS OPERATING ON THE GREAT LAKES TO COMPLY WITH
- 21 BALLAST WATER MANAGEMENT PRACTICES DESIGNED TO MINIMIZE THE
- 22 SPREAD OF AQUATIC NUISANCE SPECIES IN THE GREAT LAKES AND REQUIRE
- 23 THE TREATMENT OF BALLAST WATER AND SEDIMENTS FOR OCEANGOING COM-
- 24 MERCIAL VESSELS.

- 27 are enacted into law:
