## **HOUSE BILL No. 4415**

March 6, 2001, Introduced by Reps. Anderson, Bogardus, Neumann, Rivet, Switalski, Gosselin, Woodward, Basham, Clark, Plakas, Kilpatrick and Lemmons and referred to the Committee on Redistricting and Elections.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law," by amending section 744 (MCL 168.744), as amended by 1995 PA 261.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 744. (1) An election inspector or any other person in
