A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code," by amending section 1233 (MCL 380.1233), as amended by 2000 PA 288.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1233. (1) Except as otherwise provided by law, the
- 2 board of a school district or intermediate school board of an
- 3 intermediate school district shall not permit a teacher who does
- 4 not hold a valid teaching certificate to teach in a grade or
- 5 department of the school.

- 1 (7) If the board of a school district or intermediate school
- 2 board of an intermediate school district chooses to employ an
- 3 individual who does not hold a valid teaching certificate to
- 4 serve in a counseling role, as permitted under subsection (2),
- 5 the school board or intermediate school board shall comply with
- 6 sections 1230 and 1230a with respect to that individual to the
- 7 same extent as required for employing a person with a teaching
- 8 certificate to serve as a teacher.
