THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. That portion of highway I-69 beginning at exit 105
- 2 in Shiawassee county and extending east to exit 135 in Genesee
- 3 county shall be named the "Pearl Harbor Memorial Highway".
- 4 Sec. 2. The state transportation department shall only pro-
- 5 vide for the erection of suitable markers indicating the name of
- 6 the highway when sufficient private contributions are received to
- 7 completely cover the cost of erecting those markers.
