A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1294.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1294. (1) SCHOOL DISTRICTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO DEVELOP
- 2 AND IMPLEMENT PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT CONTRACTS WITH PARENTS OF
- 3 PUPILS. THESE PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT CONTRACTS SHOULD BE VOLUNTARY
- 4 AND SHOULD BE DESIGNED TO ENCOURAGE AND FACILITATE A PARENT'S
- 5 INVOLVEMENT IN HIS OR HER CHILD'S EDUCATION.
- 6 (2) NOT LATER THAN 90 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS
- 7 SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP AND MAKE AVAILABLE TO
- 8 SCHOOL DISTRICTS A MODEL PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT CONTRACT THAT MAY
