

HOUSE BILL No. 4666

April 24, 2001, Introduced by Rep. Rocca and referred to the Committee on Employment Relations, Training and Safety.

A bill to expand certain criteria for the promotion of certain public safety employees.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. An eligible public safety employee shall not be
2 promoted based solely on seniority.

3 Sec. 2. As used in this act:

4 (a) "Eligible public safety employee" means a police officer
5 or firefighter not subject to a civil service system established
6 pursuant to 1935 PA 78, MCL 38.501 to 38.518.

7 (b) "Firefighter" means a member of an organized fire
8 department who is responsible for fire suppression and other fire
9 related services. Firefighter does not include a member of the
10 state classified civil service system.

11 (c) "Police officer" means a sheriff or sheriff's deputy, a
12 village or township marshal, or an officer of the police

1 department of any city, village, or township. Police officer
2 does not include a state police trooper or sergeant or a member
3 of the state classified civil service system.
