THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 43702. The game and fish protection trust fund is cre-
- 2 ated for the benefit of the people of this state and shall con-
- 3 sist of the following:
- 4 (a) Gifts, grants, or bequests conveyed to the trust fund,
- 5 or income derived from such gifts, grants, or bequests.
- **6** (b) All funds transferred to the game and fish protection
- 7 fund by section 1909(a).
- 8 (c) From October 1, 1985, through September 30, 1987,
- 9 royalties that would have accrued under the Kammer recreational
- 10 land trust fund act of 1976, former Act No. 204 of the Public

- 1 Acts of 1976, and would have been deposited in the game and fish
- 2 protection trust account created in section 4 of that former

- 4 (C) (d) After September 30, 1987, bonuses BONUSES,

- 1 Sec. 43703. (1) The interest and earnings from the trust
- 2 fund shall be deposited in the game and fish protection fund.
- 3 (2) IF THE TRUST FUND'S CORPUS EXCEEDS \$85,000,000.00 ON
- 4 SEPTEMBER 30, 2001, THE AMOUNT IN EXCESS OF \$85,000,000.00 SHALL
- 5 BE TRANSFERRED TO THE GAME AND FISH PROTECTION FUND.
- 6 (3) The corpus of the trust fund shall be maintained by the
- 7 state treasurer in a manner that will provide for future dis-
- 8 bursements to the game and fish protection fund from the trust
- 9 fund's interest and earnings.
- 10 Sec. 43704. The state treasurer shall direct the investment
- 11 of the trust fund. and shall invest the trust fund in the same
- 12 manner as surplus funds are invested.
