

HOUSE BILL No. 4965

June 14, 2001, Introduced by Rep. Richner and referred to the Committee on Redistricting and Elections.

A bill to divide this state into 110 representative and 38 senatorial districts; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state departments and officers.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. This state is divided into 110 representative

4 Sec. 3. The secretary of state shall prepare a map and a
5 legal description of each district constituted under this act.
6 The legal description shall be in terms of political subdivi-
7 sions, such as counties, cities, and townships; man-made fea-
8 tures, such as streets, roads, highways, and railroads; and natu-
9 ral features, such as waterways, which political subdivisions and
10 man-made and natural features form the boundaries of the
11 district. The secretary of state shall convey the map and legal
12 description of each district to the legislature and the
13 governor.

14 Sec. 4. As used in this act:

15 (a) "Block" means block as that term is used by the United
16 States department of commerce, bureau of the census in conducting
17 the 2000 decennial census.

18 (b) "ED" means enumeration district as that term is used by
19 the United States department of commerce, bureau of the census in
20 conducting the 2000 decennial census.

21 (c) "Tract" means tract as that term is used by the United
22 States department of commerce, bureau of the census in conducting
23 the 2000 decennial census.
