

HOUSE BILL No. 4980

June 21, 2001, Introduced by Reps. DeWeese, Julian, Bernero, Voorhees, Gilbert, Drolet, Neumann, Van Woerkom, Toy, Kuipers, Vear, Kooiman, Hager, Whitmer, Jelinek, Bovin, Ehardt, DeVuyst, Phillips and Lemmons and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to name a certain portion of highway I-69 the "Purple Heart Highway"; and to prescribe certain duties of the state transportation department.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. That portion of highway I-69 beginning at the
2 intersection of I-69 east and U.S. 27 north in Clinton county and
3 extending east to exit 105 in Shiawassee county shall be named
4 the "Purple Heart Highway".

5 Sec. 2. The state transportation department shall only pro-
6 vide for the erection and maintenance of suitable markers indi-
7 cating the name of the highway when sufficient private contribu-
8 tions are received to completely cover the cost of erecting those
9 markers.
