## **HOUSE BILL No. 4999**

June 28, 2001, Introduced by Reps. Basham, Bernero and Lemmons and referred to the Committee on Insurance and Financial Services.

A bill to amend 1969 PA 317, entitled "Worker's disability compensation act of 1969," by amending section 801 (MCL 418.801), as amended by 1994 PA 271.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 801. (1) Compensation shall be paid promptly and
- 2 directly to the person entitled thereto and shall become due
- 3 and payable on the fourteenth day after the employer has notice
- 4 or knowledge of the disability or death, on which date all com-
- 5 pensation then accrued shall be paid. Thereafter compensation
- 6 shall be paid in weekly installments. COMPENSATION OR A LUMP SUM
- 7 REQUIRED TO BE PAID UNDER A SETTLEMENT OR REDEMPTION AGREEMENT IS
- 8 DUE AND OWING ON THE DATE OF THE SETTLEMENT OR REDEMPTION
- 9 AGREEMENT, AND IS PAYABLE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS OF THE

- 1 SETTLEMENT OR REDEMPTION AGREEMENT. Every carrier shall keep a
- 2 record of all payments made under this act and of the time and
- 3 manner of making the payments and shall furnish reports, based
- 4 upon these records, to the bureau as the director may reasonably
- 5 require.
- **6** (2) If weekly compensation benefits, <del>or</del> accrued weekly
- 7 benefits, -are BENEFITS UNDER A SETTLEMENT, OR A LUMP SUM UNDER
- 8 A REDEMPTION AGREEMENT IS not paid within 30 days after becoming
- 9 due and payable, in cases where there is not an ongoing dispute,
- 10 \$50.00 per day shall be added and paid to the worker for each day
- 11 over 30 days in which the benefits are not paid. Not HOWEVER,
- 12 FOR A DELAY IN PAYING WEEKLY COMPENSATION BENEFITS OR ACCRUED
- 13 WEEKLY BENEFITS, NOT more than \$1,500.00 in total may be added
- 14 pursuant to UNDER this subsection.
- 15 (3) If medical bills or travel allowance are not paid within
- 16 30 days after the carrier has received notice of nonpayment by
- 17 certified mail, in cases where there is no ongoing dispute,
- 18 \$50.00 or the amount of the bill due, whichever is less, shall be
- 19 added and paid to the worker for each day over 30 days in which
- 20 the medical bills or travel allowance are not paid. Not more
- 21 than \$1,500.00 in total may be added pursuant to UNDER this
- 22 subsection.
- 23 (4) For purposes of rate-making, daily charges paid under
- **24** subsection (2) -shall DO not constitute elements of loss.
- 25 (5) An employer who has notice or knowledge of the disabil-
- 26 ity or death and fails to give notice to the carrier shall pay

- 1 the penalty provided for in UNDER subsection (2) for the period
- 2 during which the employer failed to notify the carrier.
- 3 (6) When weekly compensation is paid <del>pursuant to</del> UNDER an
- 4 award of a worker's compensation magistrate, an arbitrator, the
- 5 board, the appellate commission, or a court, interest on the com-
- 6 pensation shall be paid at the rate of 10% per annum from the
- 7 date each payment was due, until paid.
