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## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- SEC. 18605. (1) A CONTACT LENS PROVIDER SHALL NOT DISPENSE, 1
- 2 SELL, OR PROVIDE CONTACT LENSES TO A STATE RESIDENT EXCEPT PURSU-
- 3 ANT TO AN UNEXPIRED CONTACT LENS PRESCRIPTION. THE CONTACT LENS
- 4 PRESCRIPTION SHALL INCLUDE AT A MINIMUM ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 5 (A) FOR SOFT HYDROPHILIC CONTACT LENSES:
- HOUSE BILL No. 5378 (i) BRAND OR TRADE NAME.
  - (ii) QUANTITY OF LENSES TO BE DISPENSED.
  - (iii) NUMBER OF ALLOWABLE REFILLS.
  - (iv) IF APPLICABLE, SPECIAL FEATURES.
    - (B) FOR RIGID GAS PERMEABLE CONTACT LENSES:

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- 1 (i) PERIPHERAL CURVE OR CURVES, INCLUDING CURVATURE AND
- 2 WIDTH.
- 3 (ii) OPTICAL ZONE DIAMETER.
- 4 (iii) CENTER THICKNESS.
- 5 (iv) LENS MATERIAL.
- 6 (v) IF APPLICABLE, SPECIAL FEATURES.
- 7 (C) FOR BOTH SUBDIVISIONS (A) AND (B) LENSES:
- 8 (i) DIOPTRIC POWER.
- 9 (ii) BASE CURVE OR INSIDE RADIUS OF CURVATURE.
- 10 (iii) DIAMETER.
- 11 (iv) COLOR OR TINT.
- 12 (v) LENS WEARING SCHEDULE.
- 13 (vi) TYPED OR COMMERCIALLY PRINTED NAME, OFFICE ADDRESS, AND
- 14 TELEPHONE NUMBER OF PRESCRIBING PHYSICIAN OR OPTOMETRIST.
- 15 (vii) DATE OF ISSUANCE.
- 16 (viii) PATIENT'S NAME.
- 17 (ix) SIGNATURE OF PRESCRIBING PHYSICIAN OR OPTOMETRIST.
- 18 (x) PRESCRIPTION EXPIRATION DATE.
- 19 (xi) NUMBER OF PERMITTED REFILLS.
- 20 (2) A CONTACT LENS PRESCRIPTION SHALL BE BASED UPON A COM-
- 21 PREHENSIVE VISION AND EYE HEALTH EXAMINATION, A DIAGNOSTIC TRIAL
- 22 CONTACT LENS EVALUATION, AND A FOLLOW-UP EVALUATION OF THE CON-
- 23 TACT LENS ON THE PATIENT'S EYE BY THE PRESCRIBING PHYSICIAN OR
- 24 OPTOMETRIST. THE CONTACT LENS EVALUATION SHALL BE PRESUMED COM-
- 25 PLETED IF THERE IS NO CONTACT LENS RELATED APPOINTMENT SCHEDULED
- 26 WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE MOST RECENT VISIT BY THE PATIENT TO THE
- 27 PRESCRIBING PHYSICIAN OR OPTOMETRIST.

- (3) A PATIENT'S HEALTH RECORD IS NOT A CONTACT LENS
   PRESCRIPTION.
   SEC. 18607. (1) A CONTACT LENS PROVIDER SHALL NOT REFILL A
- 4 CONTACT LENS PRESCRIPTION THAT IS WITHIN 60 DAYS OF ITS EXPIRA-
- 5 TION DATE WITH MORE THAN THE QUANTITY OF REPLACEMENT SOFT CONTACT
- 6 LENSES NEEDED THROUGH THE PRESCRIBED EXPIRATION DATE BASED ON THE
- 7 PRESCRIBED WEARING SCHEDULE.
- 8 (2) IF THE ORIGINAL WRITTEN CONTACT LENS PRESCRIPTION IS NOT
- 9 AVAILABLE TO A CONTACT LENS PROVIDER, THE CONTACT LENS PROVIDER
- 10 SHALL CONFIRM THE SPECIFICS OF THE CONTACT LENS PRESCRIPTION WITH
- 11 THE PRESCRIBER OR HIS OR HER AGENT, PRIOR TO DISPENSING, SELLING,
- 12 OR OTHERWISE PROVIDING ANY CONTACT LENSES AND SHALL MAINTAIN A
- 13 WRITTEN RECORD OF THAT COMMUNICATION. THE PRESCRIBER OR HIS OR
- 14 HER AGENT SHALL CONFIRM THE SPECIFICS OF THE PRESCRIPTION WITH
- 15 THE CONTACT LENS PROVIDER WITHIN 2 BUSINESS DAYS OF A REQUEST.

- 17 effect unless all of the following bills of the 91st Legislature
