

HOUSE BILL No. 5382

November 1, 2001, Introduced by Rep. Mortimer and referred to the Committee on Commerce.

A bill to amend 1962 PA 174, entitled
"Uniform commercial code,"
by amending section 9201 (MCL 440.9201), as amended by 2000 PA
348.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 9201. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this act, a
2 security agreement is effective according to its terms between
3 the parties, against purchasers of the collateral, and against
4 creditors.

3 (3) In case of conflict between this article and a rule of
4 law, statute, or regulation described in subsection (2), the rule
5 of law, statute, or regulation controls. Failure to comply with
6 a statute or regulation described in subsection (2) has only the
7 effect the statute or regulation specifies.

8 (4) This article does not validate any rate, charge, agree-
9 ment, or practice that violates a rule of law, statute, or regu-
10 lation described in subsection (2), or extend the application of
11 the rule of law, statute, or regulation to a transaction not oth-
12 erwise subject to it.

13 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take
14 effect unless House Bill No. 4812 of the 91st Legislature is
15 enacted into law.
