THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 411T. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT OBTAIN OR POSSESS A BLUE-
- 2 PRINT, EVACUATION PLAN, OR OTHER DIAGRAM OR DESCRIPTION OF A
- 3 PUBLIC BUILDING, OR ENGAGE IN SURVEILLANCE OF A PUBLIC BUILDING,
- 4 FOR THE PURPOSE OF COMMITTING A FELONY WITH THE INTENT TO DO ANY
- 5 OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 6 (A) INTIMIDATE OR COERCE A CIVILIAN POPULATION OF THIS STATE
- 7 OR A LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT OF THIS STATE.
- 8 (B) INFLUENCE THE POLICY OF THIS STATE OR A LOCAL UNIT OF
- 9 GOVERNMENT OF THIS STATE BY INTIMIDATION OR COERCION.

- 13 OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 14 (A) A BUILDING OWNED OR OPERATED BY FEDERAL, STATE, OR LOCAL
- 15 GOVERNMENT OR BY A PUBLIC UNIVERSITY.
- 16 (B) A PRIVATELY OWNED BUILDING, ENCLOSURE, OR OTHER FACILI-
- 17 TY, ALL OR PART OF WHICH IS REGULARLY OPEN TO THE PUBLIC.
