"An act to adopt and prescribe the design of a state coat-of-arms and state flag, and their use, and to prohibit the use of the same for advertising purposes, and to provide a punishment for such forbidden use,"

by amending section 7 (MCL 2.27).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 7. (1) The flag of the United States and the state
- 2 flag bearing the arms of the state —, shall be displayed upon
- 3 the capitol building during the daily sessions of the legislature
- 4 and of the supreme court —, and on public occasions.
- 5 (2) THE FLAG OF THE UNITED STATES AND THE POW/MIA FLAG SHALL
- 6 BE DISPLAYED ON THE FLAGPOLE ABOVE THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
- 7 CHAMBER OF THE CAPITOL BUILDING DURING THE LEGISLATIVE SESSION
- 8 DAYS OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND ON PUBLIC OCCASIONS.
