THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1285a. (1) If a school district or intermediate school
- 2 district operates a child care center, AS DEFINED IN SECTION 1 OF
- 3 1973 PA 116, MCL 722.111, then, except as provided in this sub-
- 4 section, the child care center is subject to the requirements of
- 5 Act No. 116 of the Public Acts of 1973, being sections 722.111
- 6 to 722.128 of the Michigan Compiled Laws 1973 PA 116,
- 7 MCL 722.111 TO 722.128. If a child care center established and
- 8 operated by a school district or intermediate school district is
- 9 located in a school building that is approved and inspected by
- 10 the state fire marshal or other similar authority as provided in

- 1 section 3 of Act No. 306 of the Public Acts of 1937, being
- 2 section 388.853 of the Michigan Compiled Laws 1937 PA 306,
- 3 MCL 388.853, for school purposes and is in compliance with school

- 5 fire inspector certified pursuant to section 2b of the fire pre-

- 15 AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAM FOR CHILDREN IN GRADES K TO 8, ALL OF THE
- 16 FOLLOWING APPLY TO THE OPERATION OF THE PROGRAM:
- 17 (A) THE PROGRAM SHALL HAVE A CHILD TO STAFF MEMBER RATIO
- 18 THAT IS NO GREATER THAN THE AVERAGE PUPIL TO TEACHER RATIO DURING
- 19 SCHOOL HOURS IN THAT SCHOOL DISTRICT OR INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DIS-

- 24 (C) IF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT
- 25 USES ITS EMPLOYEES TO STAFF THE PROGRAM, BEFORE ASSIGNING A STAFF
- 26 MEMBER TO WORK IN THE PROGRAM, THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR
- 27 INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL COMPLY WITH SECTIONS 1230 AND

- 1 1230A WITH RESPECT TO THAT INDIVIDUAL TO THE SAME EXTENT AS IF
- 2 THE INDIVIDUAL WERE BEING HIRED AS A TEACHER. IF THE SCHOOL DIS-
- 3 TRICT OR INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT CONTRACTS FOR THE OPERATION
- 4 OR STAFFING OF THE PROGRAM, THE CONTRACT SHALL CONTAIN ASSURANCE
- 5 THAT THE CONTRACTING PERSON OR ENTITY, BEFORE ASSIGNING AN INDI-
- 6 VIDUAL TO WORK IN THE PROGRAM, WILL COMPLY WITH SECTIONS 1230 AND
- 7 1230A WITH RESPECT TO THAT INDIVIDUAL TO THE SAME EXTENT AS IF
- 8 THE PERSON OR ENTITY WERE A SCHOOL DISTRICT EMPLOYING THE INDI-
- 9 VIDUAL AS A TEACHER. THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE SHALL PRO-
- 10 VIDE INFORMATION TO A SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DIS-
- 11 TRICT, OR CONTRACTING PERSON OR ENTITY REQUESTING INFORMATION
- 12 UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION TO THE SAME EXTENT AS IF THE SCHOOL DIS-
- 13 TRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PERSON OR ENTITY WERE A
- 14 SCHOOL DISTRICT MAKING THE REQUEST UNDER SECTION 1230 OR 1230A.
- 15 (D) THE BOARD OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL
- 16 DISTRICT SHALL DEVELOP, ADOPT, AND ANNUALLY REVIEW A POLICY CON-
- 17 CERNING THE PROGRAM THAT, AT A MINIMUM, ADDRESSES SAFETY PROCE-
- 18 DURES FOR THE PROGRAM, INCLUDING AT LEAST EMERGENCY PROCEDURES
- 19 SUCH AS ACCESS TO STUDENT EMERGENCY INFORMATION AND ACCESS TO
- 20 TELEPHONES, FOOD SAFETY, AND DISCIPLINE.
- 21 (E) NOT LATER THAN SEPTEMBER 1 OF EACH SCHOOL YEAR, THE
- 22 BOARD OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT
- 23 SHALL ADOPT AND SUBMIT TO THE SECRETARY OF THE INTERMEDIATE
- 24 SCHOOL BOARD A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THAT THE PROGRAM AND THE COR-
- 25 RESPONDING POLICIES COMPLY WITH THIS SECTION. THIS SUBMISSION
- 26 SHALL INCLUDE A COPY OF THE POLICY UNDER SUBDIVISION (D).

- 1 (3) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP AND MAKE AVAILABLE A MODEL
- 2 BEFORE- OR AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAM POLICY THAT ADDRESSES HUMAN
- 3 RELATIONSHIPS; INDOOR ENVIRONMENT; OUTDOOR ENVIRONMENT; ACTIVI-
- 4 TIES; SAFETY, HEALTH, AND NUTRITION; AND ADMINISTRATION. A
- 5 SCHOOL DISTRICT OR INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT IS NOT REQUIRED
- 6 TO USE THIS MODEL PROGRAM POLICY.
