- 4 pursuant to this part is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a
- 5 fine of not more than \$1,000.00 for each violation and costs of
- 6 prosecution and, if in default of payment of fine and costs,
- 7 imprisonment for not more than 6 months. Each day upon which a
- 8 violation occurs is a separate offense.
