by amending section 797 (MCL 168.797), as amended by 1992 PA 8.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 797. (1) Not less than 30 minutes before the opening
- 2 of the polls, the inspectors of election INSPECTORS shall
- 3 arrive at the polling place and prepare the polling place for
- 4 voting. The -inspectors of election INSPECTORS shall determine
- 5 that the correct ballot has been provided to the precinct by com-
- 6 paring the ballot provided with the sample ballot and any other
- 7 documents provided to the precinct. The inspectors of election

- 9 electronic voting system and certify in writing that the

- 3 (2) IF ELECTRONIC TABULATING EQUIPMENT IN USE AT THE POLLING
