A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 8322 (MCL 324.8322).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 8322. (1) The director may do all of the following:
- 2 (a) Declare as a pest any form of plant or animal life,
- 3 except viruses, nematodes, bacteria, or other microorganisms on
- 4 or in living human beings or other animals, that is injurious to
- 5 health or the environment.
- **6** (b) Determine the toxicity of pesticides to human beings.
- 7 The director shall use AS A GUIDE IN THIS DETERMINATION the data
- 8 in support of THE registration and OF THE PESTICIDE AND ITS
- 9 classification as a quide in this determination GENERAL OR
- 10 RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDE.

- 1 (c) Determine pesticides, and quantities of substances
- 2 contained in pesticides, that are injurious to the environment.
