## **HOUSE BILL No. 6149**

May 29, 2002, Introduced by Reps. Kolb, Bovin, Anderson, Schauer, Gieleghem, Phillips, Lipsey, Rivet, Dennis and Lemmons and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to provide for a study on the feasibility of using vehicles powered by alternative fuel; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies and departments.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 "alternative fuel and vehicle act".
- 3 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 4 (a) "Alternative fuel" means electricity, ethanol, and natu-
- 6 (b) "Department" means the state transportation department.
  - (c) "Vehicle" means an automobile, truck, van, or sport utility vehicle that is normally powered by gasoline or diesel
  - fuel but can utilize alternative fuel as an exclusive source of
- 10 fuel or in combination with gasoline or diesel fuel.
