- 1 Sec. 9. (1) Except for signs existing on March 31, 1972, a
- 2 permit shall be issued or denied BY THE DEPARTMENT within 10
- 3 business days after proper receipt of FROM THE DATE the permit
- 4 form and the permit fee IS RECEIVED from the applicant. A permit
- 5 shall not be issued for a sign -which is prohibited by section
- 6 18(a), (b), (c), or (d). A permit shall not be issued for a sign
- 7 that violates this act unless the sign is eligible for removal
- 8 compensation under section 22.
 - (2) NO MORE THAN 10,000 PERMITS SHALL BE ALLOWED FOR SIGNS IN THIS STATE. IF MORE THAN 10,000 PERMITS EXIST ON THE
- 11 EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SUBSECTION,
