June 13, 2002, Introduced by Reps. Kolb, Jamnick, Minore and Lemmons and referred to the Committee on Land Use and Environment.

A bill to amend 1921 PA 207, entitled "City and village zoning act,"

by amending section 1 (MCL 125.581), as amended by 1995 PA 36.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. (1) The legislative body of a city or village may
- 2 ADOPT A ZONING ORDINANCE TO regulate and restrict the use of land

- 10 (2) FOR THE PURPOSES SET FORTH IN SUBSECTION (1), A ZONING
- 11 ORDINANCE may divide a city or village into districts of the
