A bill to amend 1973 PA 116, entitled

"An act to provide for the protection of children through the licensing and regulation of child care organizations; to provide for the establishment of standards of care for child care organizations; to prescribe powers and duties of certain departments of this state and adoption facilitators; to provide penalties; and to repeal acts and parts of acts,"

(MCL 722.111 to 722.128) by adding section 9.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 9. (1) A STAFF MEMBER SHALL NOT BE PRESENT IN A CHILD
 - CARE CENTER IF HE OR SHE HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF EITHER OF THE
- 3 FOLLOWING:
 - (A) CHILD ABUSE OR CHILD NEGLECT.
- 5 (B) A FELONY INVOLVING HARM OR THREATENED HARM TO AN
- 6 INDIVIDUAL.

- 1 (2) A VOLUNTEER SHALL NOT HAVE CONTACT WITH CHILDREN WHO ARE
