HOUSE BILL No. 6269

September 17, 2002, Introduced by Reps. Shulman and Newell and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 1984 PA 431, entitled "The management and budget act,"

(MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594) by adding section 561.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 561. (1) THE GOVERNOR SHALL ESTABLISH A GOVERNMENT
- 2 EFFICIENCY TASK FORCE TO SURVEY, EXAMINE, AND EVALUATE THE BUDGET
- 3 AND SPENDING OF EACH STATE AGENCY TO MINIMIZE OVERSPENDING AND TO
- 4 ENSURE GREATER PROGRAM EFFICIENCY AND ECONOMY.
- 5 (2) THE GOVERNMENT EFFICIENCY TASK FORCE SHALL SUBMIT A COM-
- 6 PREHENSIVE ANNUAL REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR SUMMARIZING THE BUDGET
- 7 AND SPENDING ACTIVITY OF EACH STATE AGENCY. THE REPORT SHALL
- 8 ALSO INCLUDE RECOMMENDATIONS THAT WILL MINIMIZE SPENDING AND PRO-
- 9 VIDE FOR A MORE EFFICIENT AND ECONOMICAL PROGRAM. THE GOVERNOR
- 10 SHALL SUBMIT THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE TASK FORCE TO THE
- 11 LEGISLATURE.

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- 1 (3) THE GOVERNMENT EFFICIENCY TASK FORCE SHALL CONSIST OF AT
- 2 LEAST 15 BUT NOT MORE THAN 20 MEMBERS, EACH APPOINTED BY THE
- 3 GOVERNOR. THE GOVERNOR SHALL SELECT MEMBERS WHO ARE EXPERIENCED
- 4 AND WELL-INFORMED ABOUT ECONOMIC ISSUES FROM A VARIETY OF DIFFER-
- 5 ENT SECTORS OF THE ECONOMY, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, BUSI-
- 6 NESS, GOVERNMENT, LABOR, EDUCATION, HEALTH, AND MEDIA. THE MEM-
- 7 BERS SHALL BE APPOINTED WITHIN 45 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE
- 8 OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SECTION. MEMBERS SHALL
- 9 SERVE FOR TERMS OF 3 YEARS. IF A VACANCY OCCURS, THE GOVERNOR
- 10 SHALL MAKE AN APPOINTMENT FOR THE UNEXPIRED TERM IN THE SAME
- 11 MANNER AS THE ORIGINAL APPOINTMENT. THE GOVERNOR MAY REMOVE OR
- 12 SUSPEND A MEMBER OF THE GOVERNMENT EFFICIENCY TASK FORCE FOR
- 13 INCOMPETENCY, DERELICTION OF DUTY, MALFEASANCE, MISFEASANCE, OR
- 14 NONFEASANCE IN OFFICE, OR ANY OTHER GOOD CAUSE. MEMBERS OF THE
- 15 GOVERNMENT EFFICIENCY TASK FORCE SHALL SERVE WITHOUT
- 16 COMPENSATION. HOWEVER, MEMBERS OF THE TASK FORCE MAY BE REIM-
- 17 BURSED FOR THEIR ACTUAL AND NECESSARY EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE
- 18 PERFORMANCE OF THEIR OFFICIAL DUTIES AS MEMBERS OF THE GOVERNMENT
- 19 EFFICIENCY TASK FORCE.
- 20 (4) THE FIRST MEETING OF THE GOVERNMENT EFFICIENCY TASK
- 21 FORCE SHALL BE CALLED BY THE GOVERNOR WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER THE
- 22 EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SECTION. AT
- 23 THE FIRST MEETING, THE TASK FORCE SHALL ELECT A CHAIRPERSON FROM
- 24 ITS OWN MEMBERS. AFTER THE FIRST MEETING, THE GOVERNMENT EFFI-
- 25 CIENCY TASK FORCE SHALL MEET AT LEAST QUARTERLY, OR MORE FRE-
- 26 QUENTLY AT THE CALL OF THE CHAIRPERSON OR IF REQUESTED BY 3 OR
- 27 MORE MEMBERS.

- 1 (5) THE GOVERNMENT EFFICIENCY TASK FORCE SHALL DO ALL OF THE
- 2 FOLLOWING:
- 3 (A) IDENTIFY MANAGEMENT IMPROVEMENT MEASURES FOR STATE
- 4 AGENCIES.
- 5 (B) REVIEW THE MANAGEMENT AND OPERATION PROCEDURES OF EACH
- 6 STATE AGENCY.
- 7 (C) ASSIST STATE AGENCIES IN ESTABLISHING CRITERIA FOR EVAL-
- 8 UATION PROGRAMS.
- 9 (D) EVALUATE COMMUNICATION METHODS BETWEEN STATE AGENCIES
- 10 AND THE LEGISLATURE.
- 11 (E) REVIEW THE EXPENDITURES OF EACH STATE AGENCY.
- 12 (F) REVIEW THE DELIVERY OF SERVICES BY EACH STATE AGENCY.
- 13 (6) THE GOVERNMENT EFFICIENCY TASK FORCE MAY DO 1 OR MORE OF
- 14 THE FOLLOWING:
- 15 (A) REVIEW FEDERAL AND STATE MANDATES REGARDING
- **16** EXPENDITURES.
- 17 (B) REVIEW THE DUPLICATION OF SERVICES PROVIDED BY MULTIPLE
- 18 STATE AGENCIES.
- 19 (C) RESEARCH A VARIETY OF ISSUES NECESSARY AND PROPER TO
- 20 CARRY OUT ITS FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 21 (7) THE BUSINESS THAT THE GOVERNMENT EFFICIENCY TASK FORCE
- 22 MAY PERFORM SHALL BE CONDUCTED AT A PUBLIC MEETING HELD IN COM-
- 23 PLIANCE WITH THE OPEN MEETINGS ACT, 1976 PA 267, MCL 15.261 TO

- 25 (8) A WRITING PREPARED, OWNED, USED, IN THE POSSESSION OF,
- 26 OR RETAINED BY THE GOVERNMENT EFFICIENCY TASK FORCE IN THE
