- 5 also within 24 hours file a copy of the transaction SUSPICIOUS
- 6 ACTIVITY report with the department of state police.
- 7 (2) THE BANK MAY FILE THE SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY REPORT AS
- REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (1) IN ANY MANNER THAT IS ALLOWED BY
- FEDERAL LAW OR REGULATION.
