- 1 SEC. 270. (1) FOR TAX YEARS THAT BEGIN AFTER DECEMBER 31,
- 2 2002, A TAXPAYER MAY CLAIM A CREDIT AGAINST THE TAX IMPOSED BY
- 3 THIS ACT EQUAL TO THE COST PAID IN THE TAX YEAR FOR LANDSCAPING
- AND SITE DESIGN THAT MINIMIZE STORM WATER RUNOFF FOR THE
- TAXPAYER'S PRIMARY RESIDENCE OR \$500.00, WHICHEVER IS LESS.
- (2) IF THE AMOUNT OF THE CREDIT ALLOWED UNDER THIS SECTION
- 7 EXCEEDS THE TAX LIABILITY OF THE TAXPAYER FOR THE TAX YEAR, THAT
- 8 PORTION OF THE CREDIT THAT EXCEEDS THE TAX LIABILITY SHALL BE
- 9 REFUNDED.
