## **HOUSE BILL No. 6548**

December 3, 2002, Introduced by Reps. Kowall, Bishop, Gosselin, Koetje, Pappageorge and Cassis and referred to the Committee on Conservation and Outdoor Recreation.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," (MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding section 30111a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 30111A. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT USE A DEDICATED PUBLIC
- 2 ACCESS SITE EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION. UNLESS THE DEDI-
- 3 CATION RECORDED WITH THE REGISTER OF DEEDS SPECIFICALLY PROVIDES
- 4 FOR OTHER USES, A DEDICATION FOR PUBLIC ACCESS INCLUDES ONLY THE
- 5 RIGHT OF INGRESS AND EGRESS AND DOES NOT INCLUDE USE OF THE
- 6 PUBLIC ACCESS FOR ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
  - (A) BOAT HOISTS.
  - (B) CONSTRUCTION OF DOCKS UNLESS THE PURPOSE OF THE DOCK IS
- 9 TO AID IN THE PUBLIC ACCESS AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE DOCK IS
  - AUTHORIZED BY THE OWNER OF THE RIPARIAN LAND ON WHICH THE PUBLIC
- 11 ACCESS SITE IS LOCATED.

- 18 THE PUBLIC BY A WRITTEN INSTRUMENT RECORDED WITH THE REGISTER OF
- 19 DEEDS.
