- 3 CONDUCT PROHIBITED UNDER SECTION 520B, 520C, 520D, 520E, OR 520G
- 4 AGAINST AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS LESS THAN 16 YEARS OF AGE SHALL
- 5 IMMEDIATELY REPORT THAT CONDUCT TO THE NEAREST POLICE AGENCY
- 6 HAVING JURISDICTION OVER THE VIOLATION.
- 7 (2) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
- 8 MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 93 DAYS
- 9 OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500.00, OR BOTH.
