- 5 IS 50 CENTS OR LESS:
- 6 (A) FOOD OR CANDY.
- 7 (B) CHEWING GUM.
- 8 (C) TOYS OR OTHER ITEMS DESIGNED PRIMARILY TO BE USED OR
- 9 PLAYED WITH BY CHILDREN.
- 10 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "BULK VENDING MACHINE" MEANS A
- 11 VENDING MACHINE CONTAINING UNSORTED ITEMS THAT UPON INSERTION OF
