## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 57. (1) As used in this section and sections 57a to

- 3 (a) "Adult-supervised household" means either of the

- 18 SEC. 57M. THE FAMILY INDEPENDENCE AGENCY SHALL MAKE PAY-
- 19 MENTS DIRECTLY TO A PROVIDER OF HOUSING, ELECTRICITY, GAS, OR
- 20 TELEPHONE SERVICES IF THE FAMILY INDEPENDENCE AGENCY DETERMINES 1
- 21 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING HAVE OCCURRED:
- 22 (A) THE RECIPIENT WAS CONVICTED UNDER FEDERAL OR STATE LAW
- 23 OF AN OFFENSE INVOLVING THE ILLEGAL DELIVERY, POSSESSION, OR USE
- 24 OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE.
- 25 (B) THE RECIPIENT WAS CONVICTED OF A FELONY.
