- 1 Sec. 403. (1) A health care corporation, on a timely basis,
- 2 shall pay to a member or a participating provider benefits as are
- 3 entitled and provided under the applicable certificate. When not
- 4 paid on a timely basis, benefits payable to a member shall bear
- 5 simple interest from a date 60 days after a satisfactory claim
- 6 form was received by the health care corporation, at a rate of
- 7 12% interest per annum. The interest shall be paid in addition
- 8 to, and at the time of payment of, the claim. SECTION 2006(7) TO
- 9 (15) OF THE INSURANCE CODE OF 1956, 1956 PA 218, MCL 500.2006,
- 10 APPLIES TO A HEALTH CARE CORPORATION.

- 1 (2) A health care corporation shall specify in writing the
- 2 materials -which- THAT constitute a satisfactory claim form not
