- 2 not have the effect of totally prohibiting the establishment of a
- 3 land use within a township in the presence of a demonstrated need
- 4 for that land use within either the township or surrounding area
- 5 within the state, unless there is no location within the township
- 6 where the use may be appropriately located —, or the use is
- 7 unlawful.
- 8 (2) A TOWNSHIP SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED TO HAVE MORE THAN 10%
- 9 OF THE TOWNSHIP'S DWELLING UNITS LOCATED WITHIN MOBILE HOME
- 10 PARKS.
