## SENATE BILL No. 872

November 29, 2001, Introduced by Senators SIKKEMA, DUNASKISS, JOHNSON and MC COTTER and referred to the Committee on Economic Development, International Trade and Regulatory Affairs.

A bill to amend 1967 PA 227, entitled

"An act to regulate the inspection, construction, installation, alteration, maintenance, repair and operation of elevators and the licensing of elevator contractors; to prescribe the functions of the director of labor; to create, and prescribe the functions of, the elevator safety board; to provide penalties for violations of the act; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

by amending section 3 (MCL 408.803).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3. (1) "Elevator" means the machinery, construction,
- 2 apparatus, and equipment of an incline lift, escalator, moving
