- **6** (A) DEVELOP, ADOPT, AND IMPLEMENT A POLICY PROHIBITING

- 8 (v) ANY ACTIVITY THAT INDUCES, CAUSES, OR REQUIRES THE STU-
- 9 DENT TO PERFORM A DUTY OR TASK THAT INVOLVES THE COMMISSION OF A
- 10 CRIME OR AN ACT OF HAZING.
- 11 (B) "ORGANIZATION" MEANS A FRATERNITY, SORORITY, ASSOCIA-
- 12 TION, CORPORATION, ORDER, SOCIETY, CORPS, COOPERATIVE, CLUB,
- 13 SERVICE GROUP, SOCIAL GROUP, ATHLETIC TEAM, OR SIMILAR GROUP
- 14 WHOSE MEMBERS ARE PRIMARILY STUDENTS AT A SCHOOL OR PROGRAM OPER-
- 15 ATED BY A SCHOOL DISTRICT, LOCAL ACT SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDI-
