- 1 Sec. 59. (1) A driver of a school bus shall not transport,
- 2 ALLOW TO BOARD, or permit to be transported on a school bus while
- 3 transporting pupils to and from school a person other than
- 4 pupils, persons enrolled in a school-sponsored preschool program
- 5 authorized by state or federal statute, teachers or chaperons of
- 6 the pupils or other persons authorized by the school for the pro-
- 7 tection of property or the health, safety, and welfare of the
- 8 pupils or persons attending other school related functions, or
- 9 both. This subsection shall not apply during the transportation
- 10 of persons under section 65.

- 1 (2) After the fourth Friday following Labor day of each
- 2 school year a school bus shall not be used to transport more than
- 3 100% of the number of persons for which the school bus has a
- 4 rated seating capacity.
- 5 (3) A person who violates or directs a violation of this
- 6 section is responsible for a civil infraction and may be ordered
- 7 to pay a civil fine of not more than \$100.00. A civil infraction
- 8 under this subsection shall be processed in the same manner as a
