A bill to amend 1984 PA 44, entitled "Motor fuels quality act,"

by amending section 4 (MCL 290.644), as amended by 1986 PA 127.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- **6** (2) The director shall design a uniform means of providing
