Analysis **Summary**
SB 365 (S-1) amends the State School Aid Act to require the Center for Educational Performance and Information (CEPI) to collect all information from school districts and intermediate school districts that is required by law.

Fiscal Impact
The state fiscal impact of this bill is indeterminate. The CEPI would incur additional costs associated with the gathering of the data that is now collected and compiled by other state agencies. The Center would need additional staff to collect and compile the data and would incur increased hardware and software application costs. There may also be some personnel savings from the various state agencies currently collecting the data because they would no longer be collecting the data.

The fiscal impact to school districts and intermediate school districts will vary by district. Under this bill districts will be reporting the required data to CEPI only. This may result in some initial costs for new software applications as the data may be compiled differently than under the current reporting structure.
