Summary

Senate Bill 431 would amend the State License Fee Act to increase the application, license and registration fees of various regulated occupations. The bill also provides for a sunset date of September 30, 2007, at which time the fees would revert to their current levels. The table below provides details on the fee changes.

Fiscal Impact

The bill would generate approximately \$2.87 million in additional revenue, which would replace General Fund/General Purpose funding for the support of operations of the Department of Consumer and Industry Services.
