Analysis

Summary

The bill would amend the District Library Establishment Act to limit the application of provisions that allow the number of authorized mills to be changed in a district library agreement; under the bill, this would be allowed only within a county with a population between 12,000 and 18,000. The bill also would repeal Section 25a of the Act, which allows a county with a population between 400,000 and 500,000 (Genesee County) and one or more municipalities jointly to establish a consolidated district library.

Fiscal Impact

The bill would have no fiscal impact on either the State or local units of government.
