Analysis Summary

SB 482

Currently, the school code specifies that school districts may provide for energy conservation improvements to be made to school facilities. SB 482 revises Sec.1274a of the Revised School Code to specify that school districts may contract with a qualified provider for the energy conservation

improvements to be made.

SB 761

Currently, an independent licensed architect or professional engineer is required to prepare the plans for and to supervise school construction projects. SB 761 would allow licensed architects or engineers to be directly affiliated with a qualified provider who is providing energy conservation improvements made under Sec. 1274a of the Revised School Code.

Fiscal Impact

SBs 482 and 761 would have no fiscal impact on state or local government.
