Analysis Summary

SB 516 would amend the Michigan Adoption Code by removing the reference to the victim's age and, therefore, preventing any person convicted of criminal sexual conduct in any degree or assault with intent to commit criminal sexual conduct from adopting a child.

Fiscal Impact

SB 516 would have an indeterminate fiscal impact on the State. A small increase in administrative costs may occur due to the review of additional

conviction cases.
