## Fiscal Analysis REVENUE SHARING PAYMENT DISTRIBUTION



**Bill/Sponsor SENATE BILL 575 S-1, Sen. Robert Emerson**

**Analysis** Summary

Senate Bill (SB) 575 (S-1) would amend the Glenn Steil State Revenue Sharing Act of 1971 to change the distribution of revenue sharing payments in fiscal year (FY) 2002-03 and FY 2003-04. This bill does not affect the total amount paid to local units. The FY 2003-04 total revenue sharing payments would be appropriated in SB 270 – the General Government bill.

The bill provides for modest changes to the distribution formula for FY 2002-03. In addition, the bill provides for a 3% reduction (consistent with the Executive Recommendation contained in SB 270 for total revenue sharing payments) for each local unit for FY 2003-04 from the payment each local unit received in FY 2002-03. The bill also contains provisions that would ensure a uniform percentage reduction for each local unit if actual sales tax revenue and therefore revenue sharing payments are below the estimates based on the May 2003 Consensus estimate.

## **Fiscal Impact**

This bill would have no State fiscal impact and would not change the total revenue sharing payments to local units. However, SB 575 (S-1) would alter the distribution of the revenue sharing payments to the local units, as indicated on the table below. The Executive Recommendation would not change the distribution for FY 2002-03, but would put in place a 3% uniform reduction for FY 2003-04.
