Analysis Summary

The House Fiscal Agency has not yet completed an analysis of all potential fiscal impacts of the above bills. The House Fiscal Agency has completed an analysis of House Bills 4005 and 4006 in relation to federal sanctions which could be imposed if the state does not adopt and enforce a 0.08 percent blood alcohol content (BAC) *per se* law by September 30, 2004. The sanctions could result in the withholding of

federal-aid to state transportation programs.
