CPR Requirements for Teacher Certification



Bill/Sponsor **HOUSE BILL 4038 AS INTRODUCED**, Rep. Sal Rocca

Analysis **Summary**
HB 4038 prohibits the Superintendent of Public Instruction from granting initial teaching certificates to people who do not hold a valid Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) certification.

Fiscal Impact
If this bill becomes law, new teachers seeking certification who are not already certified in CPR would be required to pay between an estimated \$30 and \$50 for an adult CPR certificate at American Red Cross Association. There would be no fiscal impact to the state.
