Analysis Summary

House Bill 4046 would amend the Sales Tax Act such that an amount equal to the balance of collections at a 4% rate on the sale of each manufactured or mobile home shall be deposited in the school aid fund (SAF). This earmark would occur after the first 60% of sales tax revenue at a 4% rate had been deposited in the SAF, and the Constitutionally mandated 15% of sales tax revenue at a 4% rate had been distributed to local units of government as per

the Glenn Steil Revenue Sharing Act.

**Fiscal Impact** 

House Bill 4046 would have no impact on sales tax collections.
